35 **Tomahawk Main Street Fall Ride M*A*S*H* Tent Request:** Jennifer Turkiewicz stated that they are
36 requesting a larger tent. She explained that in the past they were required to use the same holes to
37 stake the tent down. She said that the new tent would require different holes, but they would use
38 the same ones going forward and would patch them after the event. GARSKE agreed that the

Music on the River

Wednesdays, June 11th through July 23rd, 2025

EVENT INFORMATION

A free concert series on Wednesdays starting on July 11th and ending on July 23rd. The set up for the event starts at 3:30p.m. and the music ends at 8:00 p.m. The nightly estimated attendance is 350-900. There are no food or alcohol sales at the events. “Historically, we have had groups give away food – popcorn, WJJQ Community Supper, ice cream, etc.”

1. SITE LAYOUT

- The event takes place at Veteran’s Memorial Park.
 - In 2018 rocks were placed to keep vehicles off of the grass.
 - (6) Barricades are delivered to help keep vehicles off the grass near the Riverwalk Trail and Utility Buildings

2. RESERVATIONS

- Reservations are required for this event, there is no cost to the organizers for pavilion rental.
 - Music on the River founded/built the pavilion in 2011. The city provided demolition of the existing pavilion. It was agreed that use of the Veteran’s Memorial Park for events sponsored by Music on the River would be free of charge.

3. GARAGE COLLECTIONS

- 12 Refuse (garbage) Cans
- 0 Recycling Cans

4. RESTROOMS

- **Noted on application regarding Port-a-Potties:** *“The City has been great about providing 4 port-a-potties in total for each event and last year went very well”*
- **2024 Permit:** Four port-a-potties are provided for the event. The event organizers are requesting that the pickup/drop off fee be waived as the port-a-potties were left at Veterans Memorial Park in the prior year. They would pay the pumping fees (\$120/per unit) unless the units need to be moved for City use then the organizers will pay the pickup/drop off fee for that week.
 - If the cost has increased, the event sponsor will be responsible for paying the actual cost of pumping.

5. PARKING

- **No Parking on the Grass:** The water and sewer lines that supply the northern half of the city run through Veteran’s Memorial Park. The City stresses the importance of keeping the vehicles off the grass to avoid damage to these utilities.
- Parking is provided off-street.
- A “Do Not Park” area is kept clear for emergency vehicles.
- A drop-off area is provided for attendees when needed.
- Police Department request that the “No Parking” signs be placed by the event organizers.

- Police Department request that parking be banned on the curve by the nursing home to avoid congestion and aid in access for emergency vehicles, if needed.

6. EMERGENCY PLAN

- A first aid kit is kept on premises to be used if needed.
- Weather is monitored by the Board of Directors. If bad weather is predicted a decision is made by 3:00 p.m. to move the event to SARA Park.
- Arrangements need to be made by Music on the River with WauWui for the use of SARA Park.
