## October 2024 Monthly Report

To: Mayor Taskay, Tomahawk Health and Safety Committee, Tomahawk Common Council Members and Tomahawk Police and Fire Commissioners

The Tomahawk Police Department responded to 130 complaints/calls for service, conducted 45 traffic stops, and issued two ordinance citations during the period of October 1, 2024, through October 24, 2024. Several cases were referred to the District Attorney for criminal charges. Officers were assigned a variety of cases to investigate.

The most frequent calls for services for the month of October were:

- 911 Hang-up\ Nuisance Call (5)
- Disorderly Conduct (9)
- Medical Assistance (4)
- Suspicious Activity (11)
- Citizen Assist (8)
- Welfare Check (3)
- Accident Property Damage (4)
- Driving Complaint (4)
- Larceny/ Theft (2)
- Alarm Related Calls (5)
- All Other Offenses (4)

We handled 130 calls for service in October 2024. The provided numbers are not inclusive of all of October. In October 2023 we handled 207 calls for service. In 2023 we responded to 2721 calls for service. The numbers provided through October 2024 show the police responding to 1915 calls for service.

We were requested to complete a traffic speed study for the Highway CC and West Leather Avenue area. There was no way that this request could be completed before the Fall Ride. The officers were instructed on September 16, 2024, to spend about an hour a shift (if calls for service allowed) in the area. The officers were instructed to monitor the traffic, speeds and to log this at the office. The speed survey concluded on September 23, 2024.

On September 23, 2024, at 0800 hours the data was calculated. During approximately 12 hours (random times and intervals) 1405 motor vehicles were recorded. The area we were monitoring is designated as a 35-mph zone. The highest speed noted was 52 mph. The officers were requested to chart the highest speed they observed during the time on scene. These numbers were calculated and averaged to a high speed of 39.64 mph. Officers issued a few citations and warnings. With the average high speed at less than 5 mph over the posted limit, it does not appear that enforcement is needed in this area.

The hours for Trick or Treating in the city of Tomahawk have been set for 4pm until 7pm on October 31, 2024.

Chief Elvins will be having surgery in late October and will miss most of November recovering. Sgt Buckwalter will be the contact person for any incidents or concerns from October 22<sup>nd</sup>- roughly December 1<sup>st</sup>.
