BLOCK PARTY INFORMATION

- A block party shall mean a neighborhood social and recreational gathering of persons residing in adjacent city blocks where a portion of a street or alleyway sought to be closed and used for the gathering is completely residential. A block party is privately sponsored gathering that is not sponsored by an organization or business. A block party doesn't involve the sale of food, alcohol or other concessions.
- The purpose of a block party is to bring neighbors together to get to know each other, provide a forum for solving neighborhood problems, give a sense of safety, assist crime prevention, and build a sense of community.
- The Director of Public Works and Chief of Police may approve, approve with conditions, or deny the application for reasons of public health, safety, or welfare, or due to violation of the city code of ordinances or application state or federal law. The applicant may be requested to with the Director of Public Works and/or Chief of Police to review the application.
- Upon approval of the block party, organizers shall make arrangements with the Department of Public Works (DPW) to pick up and return barricaded. The DPW is located at 415 W. Spirit Ave.
